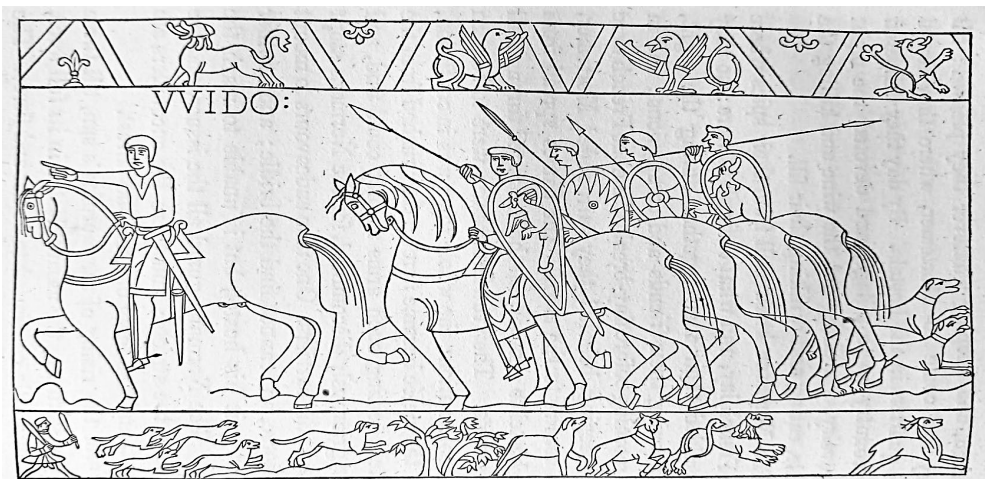
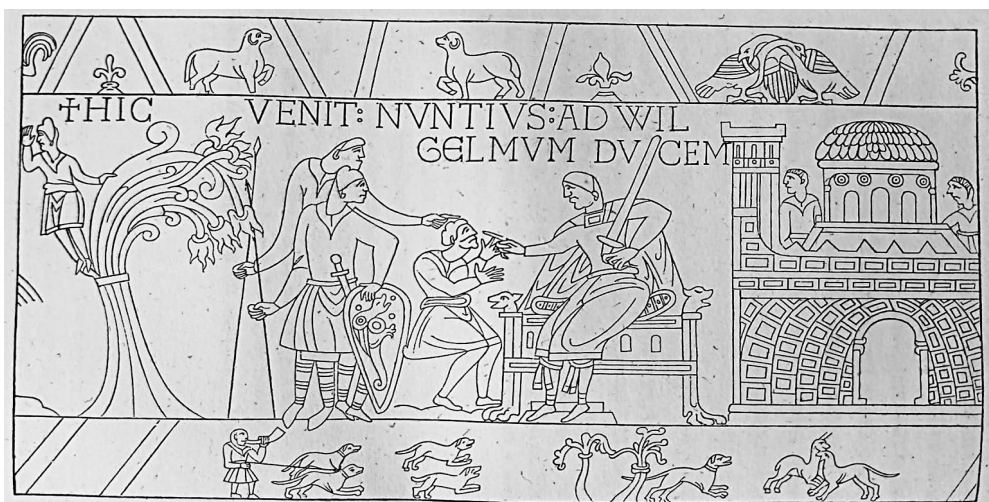




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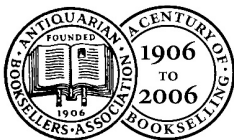

Bookpl of John Mordaunt Cope Esq, (1731-79, 8th Baronet from 1763, FRS); shelf-mark on free e-p, number at head of title, early marginal notes (mostly Latin versions of words or phrases, presumably from the Vulgate) with markings in black or red to text in Genesis chs I-III. *First edition, printed, in Junius' Pica type, from Laudian and Cottonian MSS; one of Thwaites' most substantial works and an important part of the publication of Aelfric's writings. A brave if misguided attempt to create an English national epic loosely based on the Arthurian stories and modelled on classical forms. '...accounts of Lucifer's attempts to thwart Arthur's purpose, an analysis of the development of Christianity, a catalogue of the kings of Britain...and various battles' (Lacy; Arthurian Encycl, 1986, p.47).*

Brand (1744-1806), secretary to the Society of Antiquaries from 1784, went on collecting materials for a new edition for the rest of his life; after he died without completing it the task passed to Henry Ellis.
