This was a “Gentlemen’s Agreement” arranged prior to the passing of  
the “Slaughter of Animals Act” in 1933. To set up a “Rabbinical  
Commission” for the licensing of Shochetim” (note by Bernard Homa)

According to the Act,

(i) by the Jewish method for the food of Jews and by a Jew duly licensed for the purpose by  
the Rabbinical Commission constituted in accordance with the provisions of the First  
Schedule to this Act;

Hence this ‘Gentleman’s Agreement’ was to head off any possible  
problems in the community which could endanger Shechita in the UK.  
This item was from the collection of Adi Schischa who wrote “Dr B  
Homa’s note Background History”. Dr Homa (1900-1991) was a great  
advocate for the Religious Jewish community especially in the areas of  
Schechita and circumcision. He was grandson of Rabbi Abba Werner,  
the first rabbi of the Machzike Adath community and wrote a book about

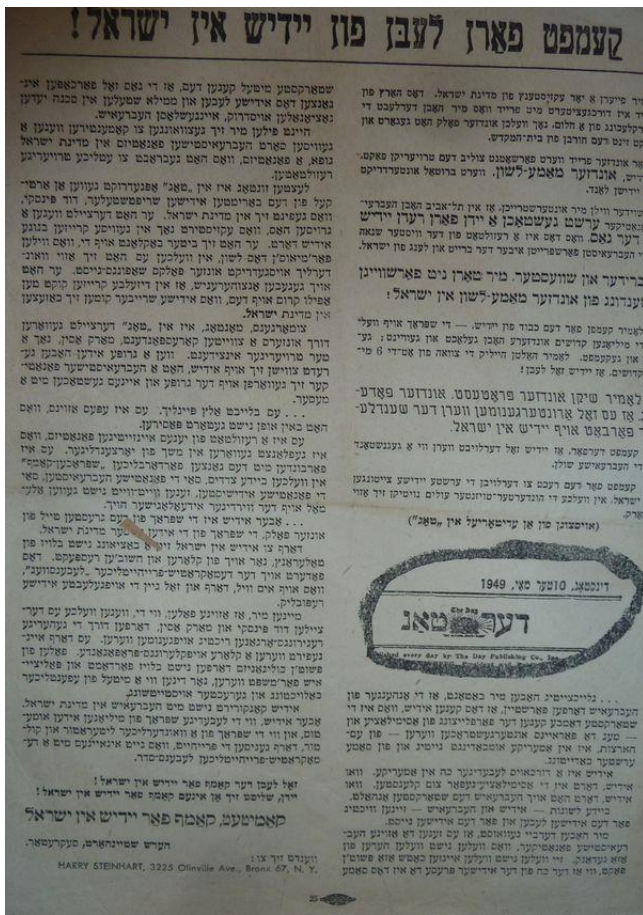
