The photographs show camp commanders, prison cells after the camp liberation, views of prisoners marching, burial sites, and gruesome images of dead victims and emaciated survivors. Four images show drawings created in the camp by Ema Blažková (1924-2003). Text in Czech OCLC 39898921. Uncommon - only about 5 copies are listed.

An early account of the author's experiences in both the notorious Gestapo-run Pankrác prison and the Theresienstadt Concentration Camp (Terezín). Prof. Antonin Macht was a political prisoner at the camp. Arrested for "anti-German activity" he was imprisoned in Terezín in the Spring of 1943. In this work published shortly after liberation, Macht documents his life under German occupation and his experiences at the camp. The text concludes with a section on women at the Terezín camp by Táňa Kulišová, a teacher who was also an inmate at the camp. Established in 1941, the camp housed mainly prominent members of the Czech Jewish community, and was used as a way station to extermination camps. Political prisoners such as Macht were in the minority, and so this text offering the political prisoner perspective on the horrors of imprisonment. [ref: 21721] **£375**

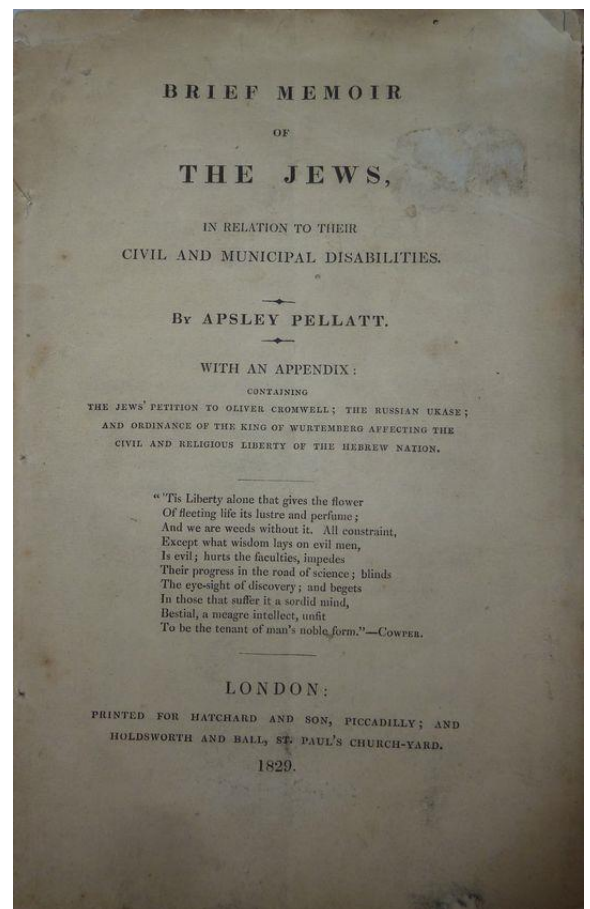


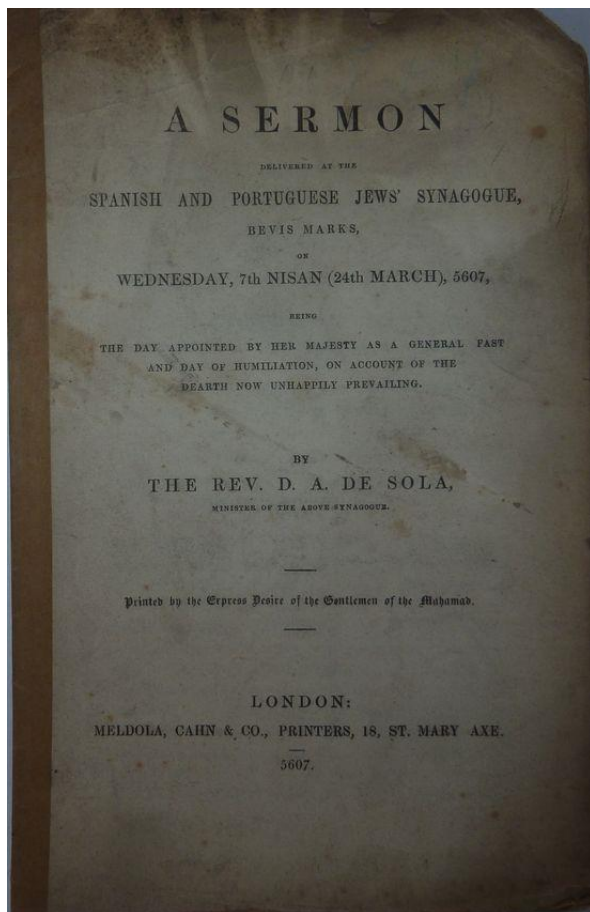

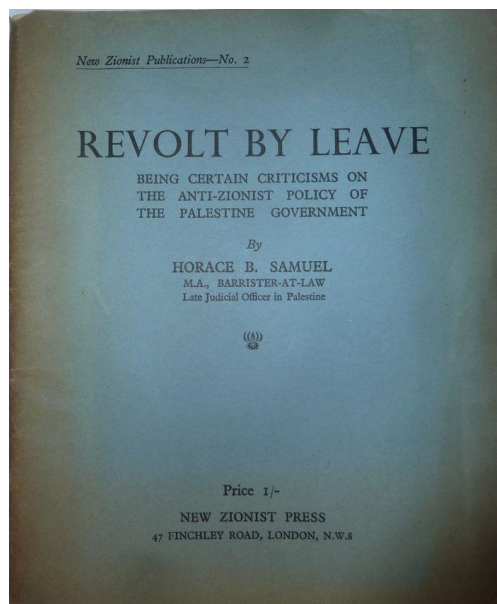
A charming momento presented to French Consul General of Jerusalem, André Favereau (1958–1959) by the father of the bride.
