Prof. Antonin Macht was a political prisoner at the camp. Arrested for "anti-German activity" he was imprisoned in Terezín in the Spring of 1943. In this work published shortly after liberation, Macht documents his life under German occupation and his experiences at the camp. The text concludes with a section on women at the Terezín camp by Táňa Kulišová, a teacher who was also an inmate at the camp. Established in 1941, the camp housed mainly prominent members of the Czech Jewish community, and was used as a way station to extermination camps. 
