Dickens made two visits to Aberdeen to present readings in the Music Hall, both very well received by his audiences, though the first, in 1858, attracted some hostile media attention in the wake of his separation from Catherine, his wife of 22 years, and his association with the 18 year0old actress Ellen Ternen. His second visit found him in poor health and able to offer only one reading, albeit in an animated, two-hour performance.

This was the second time Dickens had been asked to stand as Rector, the first being in 1849. Watson graduated M.A. in 1871 and went on to practice Law at Lincoln's Inn before serving in The War Office Postal Censorship Department in the Great War.
